on vinyl treating of fabrics

● Defense orders calling for vinyl treated fabrics for special purposes must conform to government specifications. As some of these fabrics are comparatively new, manufacturers may need help in meeting government requirements.

Geon materials are widely used in treating textiles. For example, Geon paste resin is coated on fabric to make upholstery, rainwear, safety clothing. Geon latex is used as a fabric impregnant in flame proofing, for instance, and for light weight surface treatment, such as anchor coating.

The Geon treatment interferes in no way with the utility of the fabrics. They may be washed and cleaned with most types of soaps or detergents without affecting the protective qualities. In addition, these Geon-treated fabrics can be made mildew-resistant and are comfortable to wear.
