Dear John:

I have your letter of April 29 commenting on Howard Hesselberg's memorandum of April 23, 1959, subject--California Research Corporation Cooperative Program. This memorandum was attached to a letter of mine to L. L. Huxtable dated April 24, 1959.

You are perfectly correct in your observation that in his memo Mr. Hesselberg did not spell out the fact that in Phases 1 and 2 the lead exposure and elimination of the individuals involved in blending, loading and transportation of gasoline would also be determined. It was our intention that this should in all respects conform to the procedures which will be used during Phase 3 when X-105 is under study. By copy of this letter to all of the individuals who received my original letter, I am correcting any misunderstanding that might have occurred.
