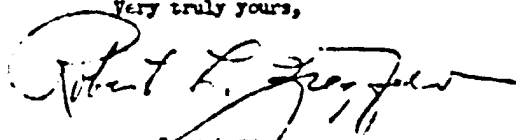
SUBJECT: METALLIC LEAD PRODUCTS DIVISION MEETING
