ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ORDER

The Court has entered an Order Establishing Certain Notice, Case Management, and Administrative Procedures (the "Procedures Order"). The Procedures Order contains information relating to, among other things:

(1) procedures governing the filing and service of motion papers, oppositions, and replies; (2) the establishment of certain preset hearing dates in these bankruptcy cases; and (3) procedures for seeking expedited hearings. The Procedures Order also establishes the scope of notice to be given in connection with all proceedings in these cases. All parties in interest will receive notice of the following pleadings: (1) any hearing on the dismissal of the case or conversion of the cases; (2) matters related to the plan of reorganization including the time fixed for filing objections to and the hearing to consider approval of a disclosure statement, the time fixed for accepting, rejecting, and objecting to confirmation of a plan or any modification thereof, and the hearing thereon and the entry of an order confirming a plan; (3) the date fixed for filing claims against the Debtors' estates; and (4) any other matter which the court requires that notice be served on all creditors and interest holders. Pursuant to the Procedures Order, in order to receive notice of other proceedings in these cases, you will be required to file with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court and serve upon counsel to the Debtors a written request for notice. EXPLANATIONS

Filing of Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Case:

A bankruptcy case under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (title 11, United States Code) has been filed in this court by or against the debtors listed in this Notice, and an order for relief has been entered. Chapter 11 allows a debtor to reorganize or liquidate pursuant to a plan. A plan is not effective unless confirmed by the court. You may be sent a copy of the plan and a disclosure statement telling you about the plan, and you might have the opportunity to vote on the plan. You will be sent notice of the date of the confirmation hearing, and you may object to confirmation of the plan and attend the confirmation hearing.

Unless a trustee is serving, the debtor will remain in possession of the debtor's property and may continue to operate any business.

Creditors May Not Take Certain Actions:

Prohibited collection actions are listed in Bankruptcy Code § 362. Common examples of prohibited actions include contacting the debtor by telephone, mail, or otherwise to demand repayment; taking actions to collect money or obtain property from the debtor; repossessing the debtor's property; starting or continuing lawsuits or foreclosures.

Meeting of Creditors:

A meeting of creditors is scheduled for the date, time, and location listed in this notice.

The debtors' representative must be present at the meeting to be questioned under oath by the trustee and by creditors. Creditors are welcome to attend but are not required to do so. The meeting may be continued and concluded at a later date without further notice.

Claims:

A Proof of Claim is a signed statement describing a creditor's claim. If a Proof of Claim form is not included with this notice, you can obtain one at any bankruptcy clerk's office.

You may look at the schedules that have been or will be filed at the bankruptcy clerk's office. If your claim is scheduled and is not listed as disputed, contingent, or unliquidated, it will be allowed in the amount scheduled unless you file a Proof of Claim or you are sent further notice about the claim. Whether or not your claim is scheduled, you are permitted to file a Proof of Claim. If your claim is not listed at all or if your claim is listed as disputed, contingent, or unliquidated, then you must file a Proof of claim by the "Deadline to File a Proof of Claim," once set by the Court, or you might not be paid any money on your claim against the debtor in the bankruptcy case.

Discharge of Debts:

Confirmation of a chapter 11 plan may result in a discharge of debts, which may include all or part of your debt. See Bankruptcy Code § 1141(d). A discharge means that you may never try to collect the debt from the debtor, except as provided in the plan.

Bankruptcy Clerk's Office:

Any paper that you file in this bankruptcy case should be filed at the bankruptcy clerk's office indicated in this notice. You may inspect all papers filed, including the list of the debtor's property and debts, at the bankruptcy clerk's office (or view electronically at www.nvb.uscourts.gov; click on RACER).

Legal Advice:

The staff of the bankruptcy clerk's office cannot give legal advice. You may want to consult an attorney to protect your rights.
