12 inhaled Kaylo dust to injure the lung."

13 The second paragraph says, "The results of
14 the investigations with animals show that Kaylo is
15 capable of producing peribronchiolar fibrosis typical
16 of asbestosis."

17 Now, am I correct that no one ever shared
18 this letter with you?
