

1 of the things that Fleischer-Drinker did was they went
2 to the shipyards, four different shipyards where the
3 naval ships and other ships were being constructed and
4 they took dust measurements, correct?

5 A Yes.

6 Q And they report all of the dust measurements
7 in these tables?

8 A Yes, they do.

9 Q And the way the authors report the figures
10 is that they have got a column for total dust and a
11 column for asbestos dust, correct?

12 A Yes. They basically try to use a little bit
13 higher magnification to estimate the proportion of
14 asbestos in the sample, although that still has a lot
15 of limitations.

16 Q And they report ranges of counts and
17 averages, correct?

18 A For both total dust and asbestos dust, yes.

19 Q And by doing that, they are taking into
20 consideration the time-weighted average that you told
21 the jury about?
