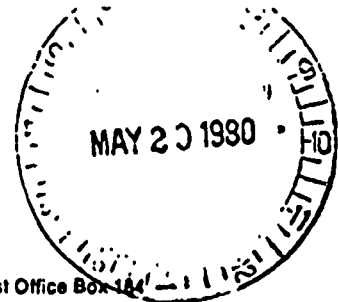

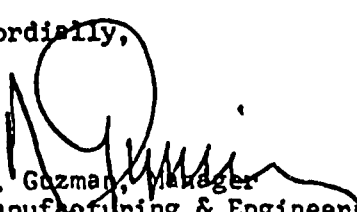
Dear Mr. Shaw:
