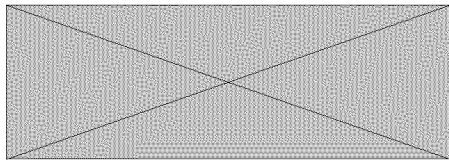

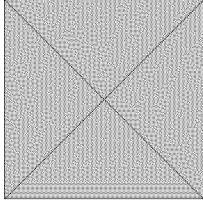
Thank you for this. Attached is the completed form.
