Subject: RE-FLO-COAT -- 04518 -

Everyone knows that it is good practice to shoot a shower coat of clear thinner over the job after the last coat of lacquer enamel, just prior to the polishing operation to give a complete reflow of the enamel, eliminating any orange peel, spray dust, or sanding scratches that may be present. Opex Re-Flo-Coat is a specially formulated thinner to give the maximum results and greatest natural gloss.

Our ever aggressive and efficient research department has given you Opex Re-Flo-Coat, which will increase the gloss at least 30% in the hands of any spray man and with some colors sprayed by experienced mechanics bring up the gloss 100%, in many cases eliminating the necessity of polishing.

Opex Re-Flo-Coat will save valuable time and labor for shops that do quality work and save the polishing operation entirely for those shops that specialize on cheaper quantity work. Wherever possible sell Opex Re-Flo-Coat as a premium for using Opex enamels.

For best results spray on a good wet coat, almost to the point of sagging, wet enough to reflect the spray gun in your hand. Lap the wet edges for uniformity. While a job can of course be polished out in less time, six to eight hours should be allowed for a thorough drying and hardening of the lacquer enamels before the polishing operation is begun.

Do not be satisfied just to sell a gallon or two to each shop in your territory but demonstrate Opex Re-Flo-Coat for an order of a case of ones or a five gallon can.

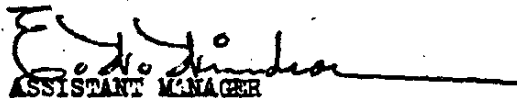
