We have been advised by our New York Office that we can proceed with our physical examinations for those employees presently engaged in occupations exposed to Airborne Concentrations of Asbestos Fibers. At the present time we have approximately fifty (50) employees that will have to be examined prior to January 31, 1973.

We were also advised that prior to the examinations a questionnaire would have to be filled out by our Plant Doctor as to each employee's symptoms of past respiratory diseases. Our first draft of the Questionnaire may be too long and may have to be revised.
