

CHICAGO FACTORY HISTORY

1879 - Warehouse established in Chicago (location unknown).

In 1903 the warehouse was moved to Chicago factory.

1880 - Purchased Calumet Paint Co. and manufacture of paint started in Chicago.

1901 - Dry Color and Insecticide plants built.

1909 - White Lead plant erected.

1911 - Started Chemical Products plant.

Began to manufacture Coal Tar products.

1917 - Manufacture of Acetic Acid and Lithopons started.

1921 - Tin Can plant built.

White Lead Dept. expanded.

1922 - Manufacture of Lacquer started.

1935 - Established Allied Research Laboratories.

1936 - Established Sulphate Wood Turpentine and Synthetic Resin plants.

1937 - Added plant facilities for production of Dispersed Colors.

1941 - Established Dibutyl Phthalate plant.

1947 - Added to Dibutyl Phthalate plant.

1946 - Power Plant completed.

Laundry placed in operation.

1979 - Austc Built

1978 - CEP Plant Built

1980 - Started Team Dmn.
