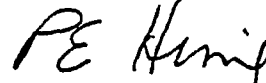
Dear Ms. Harrison:

The Celanese Chemical Company Plant at Bishop Texas finds that it is necessary to demolish about 500 feet of 2 inch pipe that is covered with friable asbestos insulation. This asbestos insulation will be removed from the pipe and disposed of. The proper procedures will be followed as to wetting the insulation, stripping it, placing it in plastic bags, and landfilling it at our asbestos disposal site.

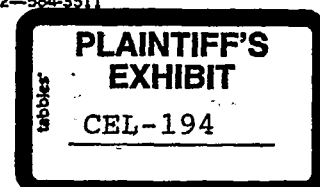
