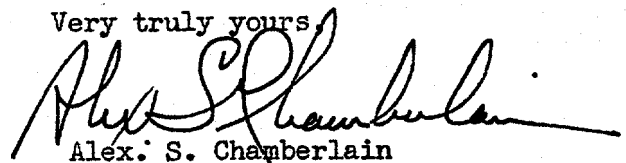
Dear Mr. Mack:
