In reply to your letter of February 15 this is to advise that this matter has been discussed with Julian Frey who is familiar with the operations of the Thompson Products Company. It is our feeling that we should cooperate with the Canton Refining Company in this request to make a special blend for Thompson.

The preferred method of handling, provided adequate circulation can be provided, for the proposed mix, would be to supply the lead by liter cans rather than by drum. This confirms my conversation with you of last week; therefore, if you are assured that this mix can be handled safely, we shall be glad to process an order from the Canton Refining Company for the required number of liter cans to be used for this purpose.

The approval of this mix should not be construed as a precedent to cover future requests for special mixes. Each one will have to be handled separately.
