No papers bearing on these practical questions seem to have appeared to supplement the information given in the paragraphs I prepared for Patty's book.

There are a few recent papers on the distribution of antimony in the blood and, to a lesser extent, spleen, liver, and thyroid, of animals given stibine or tartar emetic tagged with radioisotopic antimony. These are not helpful in answering the questions raised, but have interest for tropical medicine.
