Dear Kian-Hok:

Thank you very kindly for your telex and letter of May 29th informing us of the delay in establishing production of Pyrospray. To date in this country we have had some difficulty with the authorities pertaining to the application of asbestos-bearing spray products, however, to my knowledge, I am unaware of any restrictions pertaining to the manufacture of same.

The Keene Development Center has about finalized their re-formulation of the binder for "K-dB" Pyrospray and plant tests are scheduled for next week. Assuming that these are successful, development activities will then be continued toward an asbestos-free fire protective spray to replace the current Pyrospray Type I. However, at this time we cannot foresee completion of the second phase of this project in less than six months. Of course, as progress is made in this area we will keep you posted.
