We would like to thank you once again for taking the time to meet with us on 2 March and for giving us the opportunity to discuss our concerns about how the hazard-based approach limits the contribution of enzymes to the green transition and the EU's sustainable competitiveness, and in particular our concerns over the extension of REACH's generic approach to risk management (GRA).

We are also grateful for the constructive approach that you have taken in trying to address these concerns so that our industry can continue to provide innovative and sustainable solutions that support the EU's political objectives and bring substantial benefits to downstream industries and society as a whole.

We are currently following up on some of the points that were raised during the meeting, including a proposal for an exemption from the extended GRA (Art. 68(2)) for enzymes in the REACH text for your consideration, and an answer to your request for more information on:

- The applicability of safety practices and guidance across all Member States
- The rationale for existing exemptions for enzymes from hazard-based exclusions, such as in the Taxonomy Regulation based on the Ecolabel
- Enzymes not posing any environmental risk
- Enzymes not impairing recycling

We will respond to you on these points as soon as possible. In the meantime, we welcome your invitation for a continued dialogue and would be happy to provide you with any additional information that you would require.

Thank you once again for your time and consideration of these issues. We look forward to continuing the conversation soon.
