Dear Mr. Webb:-

Replying to your letter of April 11 just received, you are correct in your view that the diversity of citizenship in the above case permits the action to be removed to the Federal Court and our local attorneys in Columbia are taking this step before answer day. An investigation is being commenced locally over this weekend and probably next week Mr. Gillson will go down to take charge himself.

In regard to a medical examination, Mr. McGowan tells me over the telephone this afternoon that he thinks it will be utterly impossible to persuade plaintiff's counsel to consent to a medical examination, and, as you know, the defendant cannot ask for such an examination as a matter of right in South Carolina.
