Dear Representative Belaga:

I am sorry we were unable to discuss the changes I made to the Subcommittee on Outdoor Asbestos' Report and that you were unable to attend the Task Force meeting yesterday.

Richard Imbruce and I have had a serious discussion about the problems I have with the idea of promulgating an enforceable ambient air standard for the State of Connecticut. I have presented my reasons for not having such a standard on two occasions at public hearings and I am enclosing copies of my statements for your information.

I have totally revised the report which you prepared and submit it for your consideration for presentation to the Task Force.

Accompanying this letter you will find

- (1) My amendment of your original report,
- (2) The new report which I have prepared, and
- (3) My statements and submission to the DEP at a public hearing in Hartford in March, 1980.
(May I please urge you to read this carefully).

If you are unable to agree with my amendments, please accept this letter and the attachments as my dissenting minority report for attachment to the report which the sub-committee decides to submit to the task force.
