Biographies of Our Speakers

Andrew Bishop

Andrew Bishop, Senior Partner and global head of policy research at Signum Global Advisors, is an established political analyst with a 15-year track record of advising institutional investors, corporates and governments on political risks in developed, emerging, and frontier markets. Andrew is also head of Signum's Washington, D.C. office. Andrew joined Signum from Eurasia Group where he served as Deputy Head of Research and was also a Director in the firm's Global Macro practice. Prior to that, Andrew was a senior manager in the World Economic Forum's strategic foresight and risk analysis unit, during which he regularly participated in the organization's annual meeting in Davos. Andrew is a Term Member of the Council on Foreign Relations, a Munich Security Conference Young Leader, and an alumnus of the Atlantik-Bruecke. He received his

master's degrees from the London School of Economics and 'SciencesPo. Paris' and was a fellow at the Johns Hopkins University in Washington, D.C.

Sir Alex Younger

Sir Alex was appointed as a Regional Advisor in July 2021, to advise on strategic matters and to help clients worldwide better understand the environment in which they operate. Alex retired from government after completing six years as the Chief of the British Secret Intelligence Service, MI6, and thirty years as a foreign intelligence professional.
