Attached is a copy of the 1984 Sales Forecast I with a comparison to 1984 budget. You will note that an expected increase in domestic sales is slightly more than negated by a drop in export sales. The latter is due primarily to a lower sales projection for SX-14 and SX-24 by Grace GmbH, and the probable loss of 800 tons of HPP to Tomoe because of Matsushita Denko formulating asbestos out of their ceiling tile production. Although Matsushita has encountered difficulties with replacing asbestos, it is felt by Tomoe that they will not return to using our HPP.
