June 22, 1944

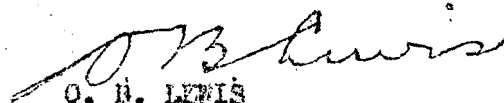
I note that Dr. Kehoe's letter of June 10 to the heads of the various activities in Detroit was also sent to both of us. Dr. Kehoe has suggested that we work through you on a program of cooperation in safety matters between New York and Detroit.

At a meeting here yesterday we explored the possible approaches to this problem. Mr. Kaley, Mr. Frey, Mr. Pope, and Mr. Costello were present. There was a general agreement that a similar session of key men in Detroit might be conducive to unifying thought on what should be done.

If you would be good enough to let me know when it will be convenient for you, and the others mentioned below, to meet in Detroit, I shall arrange to be present. Also, as the Manufacturing Department is very much interested in general safety measures, Mr. Costello would like to attend. This would then mean that all major departments would be represented.
