We are sending a urine sample from [REDACTED]

He is a 28-year old negro. Hired into Pasting on July 13, 1943 and worked there continuously until February 21, 1944 when he was transferred to non-lead work because of elevated stippled cells. Cell count in October and November 6, December 7, January - none taken, February 5" - 19, February 11" - 21, transferred 2-12-44, Feb. 17" - 25, Feb. 29" - 4, March 3 - 6.

He now reports g-l symptoms, including constipation, occassional nausea and some anorexia. Has lead line. Also has upper respiratory infection.
