2 Q And did our office provide you with an
3 occupational history?

4 A Yes, sir.

5 Q Did you make some slides, photographs of the
6 slides, that you reviewed in Mr. Vandergucht's case?

7 A Yes, sir, I did.

8 Q I would like to show you first what has been
9 previously marked as VA for Vandergucht Number 29-A,
10 and ask you if you can please tell the ladies and
11 gentlemen of the jury what this slide shows.

12 (Whereupon, Plaintiff's Vandergucht Exhibit
13 Number 29-A was marked for identification.)

14 A This is a photograph that I prepared using
15 a microscope that is equipped with a camera.

16 I looked at one of the slides, and it may be
17 the one that we are passing around, through the
18 microscope and had this attached camera where I was
19 able to make this photograph.

20 So this is the same type of image that I
21 looked at through the microscope myself.
