Demolition of Sodium Chlorate Plant

Gentlemen:

Please quote a price and required time to demolish, dismantle and stack pile PPG's Sodium Chlorate Plant equipment, not including the building structure. No drawings are included at this time. A job site inspection is needed to get the full scope of this work. However, drawings and engineering information will be supplied later as needed.

The contractor is to furnish labor, incidental material and equipment to remove all process equipment, piping, electrical, instrumentation and supports as designated by PPG. These items are to be segregated and neatly stacked in an area as designated by PPG. This stacking area will be no further than one-half mile from the job site.

The contractor is to remove all the asbestos-cement and translucent plastic panels from the roof and north wall of the plant building. These panels are to be stacked with the other items. PPG will provide connections for water, plant air and electricity if these utilities are required for this work.

The building and concrete floor will be water-blasted and cleaned by PPG prior to the start of dismantling. PPG will flush all piping and equipment prior to the start of this job.

The approximate starting date is May 15, 1972.
