1. Fire extinguishers have been placed on the Cold Mill Foundation. Do not use these water pump extinguishers for cooling metal or for the purpose of settling dust. FOR FIRE USE ONLY.

3. SHEET STRIP

Asbestos cloth is available at the laborers tool room. Let's use it where possible.

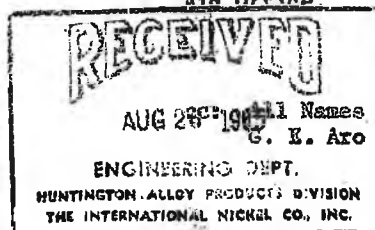
