I was a brickmason helper for some two or 3 years I would hand saw asbestos block for Brickmasons building & repairing furnaces no one told me to wear a mask this was in the early 1960.

I used a ninety pound gas hammer tearing out furnace brick to repair them they had 3" insulating (asbestos) behind the brick I would tear this out the dust would be every where no one told me to use a mask asbestos will hurt you it is a hazard to your health -

This went on for five years then I began to notice the warning on the bags & Bags we also used lots of ~~asbestos~~ ^{cellulose} a product of dolomite I think. It had a like warning on the bag -

We mixed 352 asbestos shovels with lanime cement by hand in wheel barrow first in an unvented shop - then in a semi vented shop ~~not~~ we also cut asbestos & manite on a dry cut saw that would fill the shop with dust we used several tons of these materials over the years.

The Carbon Plant started using it ^{asbestos} to patch ~~corner~~ ^{corner} of the flue walls in the carbon plant they used several tons of asbestos 352
