When I was in Pittsburgh last week Mr. McMahon, of the Industrial Hygiene Foundation, spoke to me of this experimental work which you have been doing and asked me when any information would be available. I told him that I did not know just what the present status was.

You mentioned, when here, that the information should be completed sometime in February, on the results of both of these tests. Of course, we realize that the test results will first be submitted to us and other interested parties for review and approval prior to any publication to outside parties.
