SUBJECT: CELL SERVICE DRILL

AT APPROXIMATELY 1:30 P.M. CELL SERVICE HELD A DRILL RELATIVE TO DOWANOLS HAVING AN AMMONIA SPILL WITH THE WIND OUT OF THE SOUTH EAST AT 2 MPH.

ALL PERSONNEL ASSEMBLED AT THE EAST ASSEMBLY AREA AND PICKED UP THE FULL SCOTT FACE MASK IN AN ORDERLY MANNER. THE SIGN IN ROSTER WAS BROUGHT BY E. DOMINGUE WITH ALL PERSONNEL BEING ACCOUNTED FOR. THE CATHODE LINE BROUGHT THE RADIO'S AND 2 SCOTT AIR PACKS. THE CATHODE LINE EQUIPMENT WAS SHUT DOWN. L.J. SIMS STATED FOR EVERY ONE TO GO TO THE CONTRACTOR CHANGE ROOM THAT WE WERE GOING TO SHELTER.

THE VENT FANS AND AIR CONDITIONER WERE TURNED OFF. IT WAS DECIDED THAT IT WOULD BE BETTER TO PAINT THE VENT FANS AND AIR CONDITIONER BREAKERS "RED" SO THAT THEY COULD BE LOCATED EASIER. THE BREAKERS WERE PAINTED.
