Requestor: American Public Power Association (APPA)

Purpose of the Meeting: On October 19, APPA will be hosting a meeting for its CEO Climate Change & Generation Policy Task Force – a group of approximately 30 public power CEOs that own generation and have been very involved in formulating the Association's policy positions on climate change (legislative and regulatory). We would like the Administrator to brief our CEOs on EPA's efforts to repeal and replace the Clean Power Plan.

Background on the Meeting: Typically, the Task Force meets twice a year to hear from speakers on a host of climate and Clean Air Act-related issues and to provide APPA with feedback on comments to EPA or policy positions to take on these environmental issues. The group has previously met with EPA officials from the Obama Administration and would greatly like to meet with Administrator Pruitt to discuss these important environmental issues.

Role of the Administrator: To provide our CEOs with an update on EPA's agenda on climate (and any other related Clean Air Act matters) and answer questions raised by our CEOs. We would also invite the Administrator to view the meeting as an opportunity for him to ask questions of and seek feedback from our CEOs.

Attendees: APPA President & CEO Sue Kelly and other senior level APPA staff and CEOs from public power utilities and joint action agencies in states such as Oklahoma, South Carolina, Georgia,

Indiana, Louisiana, Florida, New York, Illinois, Colorado, Connecticut, Ohio, Nebraska, Missouri, Texas, Arizona, Washington, Minnesota, Iowa, South Dakota, and North Dakota. We do not have a final RSVP list, but could provide one closer to the event date.
