Effective as of its date of issue by substituting for subsection A of
1 9 of Group Hospital Expense Insurance Supplementary Agreement Form G.H.F.6325
ad to said Group Policy as a part thereof, the following:

"(A) The Hospital Expense Insurance on any Employee
insured under this Supplementary Agreement shall automatically cease on
the date termination of his
employment occurs.

Termination of employment, for the purposes of Hospital Expense
Insurance hereunder, means cessation of active work as an Employee
as defined in Section 1 hereof, except that

- (i) in case of the absence of an Employee from active work
because of sickness or injury, his employment may, for
the purposes of his Hospital Expense Insurance here-
under, be deemed to continue until terminated by the
Employer, or
- (ii) in case of the absence of an Employee from active work
because of leave of absence or temporary lay-off, his
employment may, for the purposes of his Hospital Expense
Insurance hereunder, be deemed to continue until
terminated by the Employer but in no case beyond the
expiration of a period of two months following the date
such leave of absence or lay-off commenced.

In the case of either of the foregoing exceptions, Hospital Expense
Insurance hereunder on such Employee shall automatically
cease on the date such
termination of his employment by the Employer occurs as evidenced to the
Insurance Company by the Employer, whether by notification or by cessa-
tion of premium payment on account of such Employee's Hospital Expense
Insurance hereunder."
