Talked with Bill Vertos today about subject visit. I will arrive in Port Allegany in time for lunch on September 7. Hope you, Dick Marry, and George Gregory will be available. Would like the details of the following to prepare for my talks with employees

1. A review of Public Health Service, Pennsylvania State Health Department and Dr. Morton Corp's In-Plant Industrial Hygiene Surveys of dust exposures in the unibestos plant before and after revamping the dust control system; this specifically to determine past and present problem areas in terms of dust exposure.
2. A review of the revamping of the dust control system up to present, including any planned future changes.
3. A review of progress with Unibest production, including future plans.
4. A review of the Respiratory Protection Program, past, present, and future in terms of type respirators being used, by whom, and the respirator maintenance program.
5. A review of medical/x-ray examination program up to the present. Also, contacts made to expand the program to include medical history and pulmonary function studies. I have enclosed a copy of the program recently implemented at Tyler for your information.
6. Discuss the meeting schedule for my talks with employees. I have enclosed George Gregory's copy of the Tyler visit for your information.
