BUSINESS ITEMS ** JANUARY

The Council, like most enterprises, is not prospering -- but the following at least shows the vitality of our business:

- 1 -- The total money collected during the month was \$42,341.94.
- 2 -- A total of 22 new members were secured in January - with total income of \$2,261.70. This is the largest amount of new money for memberships received in any one month in two years.
- 3 -- 270 members renewed and sent in their dues during January. See list attached.
- 4 -- One of these renewals totaled \$1,322.14 - a "complete" membership -- second year's renewal.
- 5 -- The bills rendered for miscellaneous publications distributed in January totaled \$9,332.09.
- 6 -- The following cancelled memberships were renewed in January:
 - 2 six months old \$120.00
 - 3 old memberships salvaged \$187.50
 - 4 memberships recovered after first notice of cancellation \$157.50
 - Total 9 members and \$465.00 saved.
- 7 -- 29 contracts, maturing January 1st, were renewed for The Safe WORKER and 4 contracts for The Safe DRIVER.
- 8 -- One new advertising account was received for the NATIONAL SAFETY NEWS - many of the old contracts were renewed January 1st.
- 9 -- The number of posters distributed in January totaled 236,898 -- 2,087 more posters than December.
- 10 -- The 1933 expense budget item on calendars was cut \$1800., brought about by economies.
- 11 -- The Manager of the Civic Opera Building has made several approaches on the adjustment of our rent. Expect to have this matter settled within a few days.

The unfavorable item during the month was cancellations of memberships totaling \$3,957.50.

It is impossible to say today whether the financial experience for January was above or below the budget, but we are looking for a reasonably good showing.
