## CRITTENTON HOME TO PLAN FOR RECEPTION

PREPARATIONS FOR BAZAAR WILL BE DISCUSS'D BY AUXILIARY WEDNESDAY

Preparations for the annual bazaar and reception of the Women's Work Auxiliary of the Los Angeles Florence Crittenton Home will be discussed at a meeting of the auxiliary to be held next Wednesday evening at the home. Lopham will be served. During the day the regular monthly sale of articles made by the inmates of the home will be conducted.

A report of the work of the Florence Crittenton Home made yesterday by Mrs. Lee D. Miller, chairman of the auxiliary, showed that between July, 1922, and July, 1923, seventy-five girls and women and sixty-three babies were cared for. Of this number thirty-four girls were returned to their homes, twenty-three were found positions and four were married. Of the babies, twenty-seven were kept by their mothers, or their mothers' families, twenty-three were placed for adoption and one died.

The home is not endowed, and is primarily sustained by dependent on voluntary subscriptions for maintenance.

## DAY CITY BRIDGE FIRM ORGANIZED

SACRAMENTO, Sept. 10.—A body of incorporation for the Daybridge Highway Bridge Corporation, capitalized at \$1,000,000, will be filed with the secretary of State Frank C. Jordan. The corporation will construct a bridge

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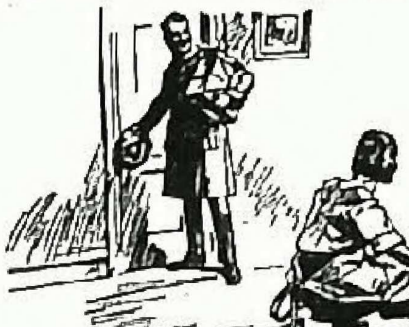
