Dear Dr. Gilbride:-

We have at present a very satisfactory cooperative arrangement with United Chemical and Organic Products Company through Mr. Jay Bowman their Technical Superintendent. During a conversation with Mr. Bowman he mentioned that your company was making fruit concentrates by a freezing method. Our interest in this particular field is to determine if it is a partial source of the lead excreted by men not having even an occasional exposure to lead either in their occupation or their odd jobs around home. We do not intend to use these data in any way which may prove detrimental to the particular food industry concerned.

We hope that we may have your cooperation in a survey of fruit products. If this is possible, please inform us as to the arrangements necessary to obtain samples.
