932-P-20266	1 Sheet of 1/8" for Grasselli, N. J.

When you were out here last you probably recall that we had a few sheets around from a P-S run which were not perfect, but which you stated were not too bad. We have not made detailed inspection of each sheet of this material but do know that it is usable even though it does not measure up to our full quality standards.
