The topic of this meeting was the danger of the Tankcar Unloading Station. Items discussed were:

1. The weakest part of VCM cars and bullets.
2. Where to direct the water in case of fire.
3. What valves to block in, in case of a leak or fire.
4. The use of water to dissipate VCM.
5. Use of wind direction when approaching a fire or VCM release.
6. Insuring safety of personnel.
7. Checking out the tank farm when a compressor trips out. May be caused by high pressure.

In addition, the failure of a VCM liquid hose at the tank farm was discussed.

John Olson discussed energy conservation and the use of 2-speed agitator motors.
