I have your letter of the 16th and as previously advised, believe that your change in Section IV should be made.

With respect to the second paragraph of your letter, this is evidently a typographical error.

In regard to the revision in Section XI, it has been broadened and for very definite reasons in no way concerned with Magnesia. As originally written, it was possible only to take action in the event that the same materials were used, but as it presently reads, it is possible to take action where similar uses are involved.

It is recognized, of course, that Magnesia is intended for a different class of uses and no action would be taken under the paragraph if licensees make and sell Magnesia.

I presume you have now seen the new list of materials and hope this is in line with your ideas.
