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ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 29, A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE AIA/NA BOARD OF DIRECTORS WILL BE HELD IN NEWYORK CITY AT JOHNS-MANVILLE, 22 EAST 40TH STREET, 11TH FLOOR BOARD ROOM, STARTING AT 11 AM, TO DISCUSS THE RECENTLY PUBLISHED FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY PROPOSED NATIONAL EMISSION STANDARDS ON ASBESTOS AND THE EMERGENCY OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH /OSHA/ STANDARD OF 5 FIBERS PER ML. ANNOUNCED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR. BOTH STANDARDS APPEARED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ON DECEMBER 7 AND WERE DISTRIBUTED IN A SPECIAL MAILING THAT SAME DAY.

IN ORDER THAT THE ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL SUB-COMMITTEE WILL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO STUDY ALL MEMBER COMPANY VIEWS AND OPINIONS ON THE STANDARDS PRIOR TO THE MEETING, WE WOULD LIKE TO RECEIVE IN WRITING OR BY WIRE, NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 21, YOUR COMPANYS COMMENTS ON BOTH THE EPA AND OSHA STANDARDS. QUESTIONS THAT SHOULD BE CONSIDERED INCLUDE-- CAN YOUR COMPANY LIVE WITH THE STANDARDS AS PUBLISHED. HOW GREAT AN ECONOMIC BURDEN WILL THEY PLACE ON YOUR OPERATIONS. WHICH SECTIONS OF THE STANDARDS DO YOU CONSIDER MOST DAMAGING. HOW DO YOU SUGGEST THEY BE CHANGED. DO YOU BELIEVE THE AIA/NA SHOULD OPPOSE OR APPEAL THE OSHA STANDARD. ON WHAT GROUNDS. ETC. BESIDES THE STANDARDS THEMSELVES, WE SHALL ALSO DISCUSS AT THE DECEMBER 29 MEETING THE NATURE OF THE INDUSTRY RESPONSE TO THE EPA STANDARDS.

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
