Per telcon with Walt Rosenberg-E. R. Kanewske this afternoon, two WISHA industrial hygienists began an inspection of Puget Sound Plant today. There was no employee nor union complaint. Reportedly, the inspection is to be a wall-to-wall inspection per opening conference which was held before lunch. Rosenberg advised that the two industrial hygienists are new and this is to be a learning experience. The inspectors have expressed interest so far in our Permit Handling Procedures, Confined Space Entry and also wish to talk to members of the joint Health and Safety Committee. Mr. Kanewske advised Mr. Rosenberg that ordinarily we try to limit the scope of such inspections and while we may want to cooperate, we should not volunteer information and end up having them cite us. Mr. Kanewske further advised that it may be well for Puget Sound to notify Western Region Legal, Mr. Evans' office in Los Angeles of the inspection for any counsel that they may wish to give.
