On Monday, November 27, 2017, Sheriff David Hobbs of Jefferson County passed away. Elected in 2004, Sheriff Hobbs served the people of Jefferson County with distinction for the last thirteen years. In honor of Sheriff David Hobbs, I hereby direct the flags of the United States and the State of Florida to be flown at half-staff at the County Courthouse in Jefferson County, Florida, the City Hall in Monticello, Florida, the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office in Monticello, Florida, and the State Capitol in Tallahassee, Florida from sunrise to sunset on Saturday, December 2, 2017.

Governor Scott said, "Ann and I are saddened by the passing of Sheriff David Hobbs. He dedicated his life to serving our country in the military and the families of Jefferson County as Sheriff.
