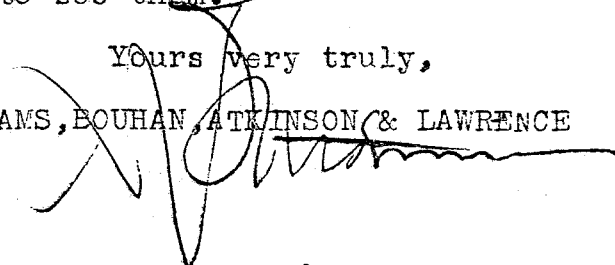
We cannot, at this time, fix a date as late as September.
