Dust Control Practices

Several points in dust control in preparation and at carding machines were discussed briefly with Mr. Williams, Jr. at the time of the visit.

The long term investigations, however, would include systematic guidance in the details of dust control especially with respect to preparation, carding machines, the cause of excessive dust, and its removal, in spinning and twisting, and selection of dust collectors. It is to be recognized that, because of the climate, this plant has a particular stake in the development of information that will permit safe recirculation of air from a dust collector.

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
