As per your request, I have signed the affidavit, however, I would point out two things in "The Application for Variance".

(1) Page 2, Paragraph (4) - We haven't discussed expanding the medical examination program at the Port Allegany plant. Not having, to my knowledge, facilities and personnel comparable to Dr. Hurst's set-up in Tyler, it may not be possible to duplicate the Tyler exams at Port. If it is your desire to have me look into this possibility, I will do so at the time of my Port visit.

(2) Page 3, First Unnumbered Paragraph, Second Sentence, should read as follows:

"The ineffectiveness of such equipment has become particularly significant since the reduction of the TLV for asbestos from twelve to five fibers per milliliter greater than five microns in length."
