This is a waiver request for one emission source at Union Carbide's King City, California Asbestos Plant as provided for in Section 61.10, of the Federal Register dated April 6, 1973. This was discussed with you by phone by Mr. R. G. Beverly, Director of Environmental Control, on June 7, 1973.

In October, 1973 we initiated projects to install two bag collectors on two product drier discharges. These projects are essentially complete and we expected to be in complete compliance with the National Emission Standards for Asbestos prior to the compliance date of July 5, 1973. For this reason we did not file a waiver request earlier. One of the bag collectors was installed and put in operation early in June. Tests of the second collector show that the manufacturer's fan curves were in error and that a larger fan is required. This waiver request is for a period until December 31, 1973 in order to purchase and install a larger fan and the required accompanying electrical distribution equipment. During this period we expect to be in compliance with the emission standard a large portion of the time in that there will be no visible emission. While producing certain products slight emissions are visible. Ambient air samples and observations indicate no significant off-property discharge will occur.

Completed Waiver Request Form OMB No. 158-RO098 is enclosed along with a chart showing the project schedule and significant dates pertaining to the completion of the project.

II. WAIVER REQUESTS

EPA USE ONLY
