As you know from our conversation of the other day, we deeply regret your decision to resign from this company and accept employment in another location.

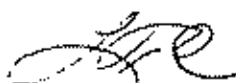
We know that you were prompted in this by the conditions which you have outlined to us, and want to extend to you our very best wishes for success in this new enterprise.
