We are in agreement with the proposed additional label paragraph relating to PCB's for electrical grade and nonelectrical grade Aroclors and for the applicable Therminol products. We would make the following comments as to deviations:

1. We would not like to see this label adapted to the Pydraul line. I think this is a reasonable approach since we are going through a reformulation of all of our products which, over a period of time, will eliminate the necessity for this paragraph.
2. Jack Fallon has previously talked to Bob Sido about a suggested Therminol label change which relates to ingestion in food. You should review this addition also, and perhaps incorporate both at the same time.
3. We should obtain approval from General Electric and Westinghouse before putting this paragraph on Pyranol and Inerteen labels. While I am sure this is just a formality, I think it would be wise to give them a shot at it before we made the actual change. Please let me know if you wish us to follow this portion.
