Subject: SMFMA General Meeting

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Bert Levine has suggested that a general meeting be called as quickly as possible so that the SMFMA organization can take a unified stand and approach on this asbestos health hazard problem. It is the writer's feeling that we should equip John Boyer with a standard reply and existing documentary information so that prompt letters can be dispatched wherever we uncover adverse comment or actions against sprayed fiber.

A case in point is the Division of Industrial Safety in California. I honestly think that some immediate action and reply should be taken sending them existing information right now. I don't think we should wait until tests are run or test methods are developed since this might take many years. I feel we have enough information at this time at least to be able to neutralize the minds of some individuals such as the Division of Industrial Safety until more concrete information can be established.

I concur with Bert Levine that a general meeting should be held as quickly as possible.
