WEATHER KING WOOD PRIMER (Oil Base)

Weather King Wood Primer (Oil Base) may be used over either unpainted or painted wood siding and trim, and wood shingles. As an undercoater for Weather King Latex House Paint, this primer improves adhesion and provides a well sealed, blister-resistant surface that will add years to the life and beauty of the topcoat.

DIRECTIONS

Preparation — Remove dirt, chalk, and loose paint. Repair flashings, caulk, and provide adequate ventilation for release of moisture. Sand under eaves and protected areas, wash with detergent and thoroughly rinse.

Tinting — Tint toward the finish color with Tone-All Universal Tinting Colors or with Oil Colors.

Application — Apply at package consistency with good bristle brush in temperature not less than 60° F. Some woods containing water-soluble dyes such as western red cedar and redwood, may require two primer coats to prevent "bleeding." Sand rough sawed lumber between primer coats to eliminate wood fiber "wicks" that carry dyes into the topcoat. Clean brushes and tools with mineral spirits or turpentine. Allow 48 hours or more good drying weather before recoating.
