8 A Use coarse sandpaper.

9 Q And what would happen when you would use the
10 coarse sandpaper on the brake lining?

11 A Create a lot of brake dust.

12 Q Where would that brake dust go?

13 A In the air that you breathed.

14 Q What was the composition of the brake lining
15 material that you were replacing?

16 A It would be asbestos.

17 Q And why do you say that?

18 A Sometimes it would be stamped on the lining
19 itself. Other times it would be printed on the box
20 that the brake shoes came in.
